#### Dear Friends,

CityFest is quickly approaching. You have probably already begun to see and hear about CityFest from signs and word of mouth across our community (and in our church. (Notice the big colorful signs in our front yard?) I'd like to share with you what CityFest is all about and outline some exciting opportunities for the Gospel surrounding that main event.

#### What is CityFest?

CityFest is, at its heart, an evangelism ministry where the Gospel of Salvaiton is brought to a community by the local community of churches at a key event of Worship, Gospel preaching by evangelist Andrew Palau and family-oriented fun. The CityFest main event will be on Saturday, May 27th with the doors opening at 2PM at the fair grounds here in town. Admission is free, and from 2-6, the grounds will be filled with a fair-like atmosphere with all kinds of fun activities for all ages. Then at 6pm, the main event starts with Christian worship artists, Ryan Stevenson,

Marisol Park and featuring the Newsboys! Internationally renowned evangelist, Andrew Palau (son of evangelist Louise Palau) will be preaching the Gospel of salvation and a well-organized team of ministers will be ready to connect with people who come to saving faith in Jesus that night (I will share more about who Andrew Palau is in next month's newsletter). linked up with participating churches for their on-going discipleship in Christ. God is on the move in bringing this powerful event to our city! As of today, over 27 churches from the Klamath Basin (including ours) have come together in partnership to bring this event to life and to surround the CityFest event itself with a platform of ministry to our community. This inter-church ministry is called CityServe.

#### From the Pastor... Continued

#### What is CityServe?

I recently sent out an email video introducing CityServe in our community and we are working to have that video played on a Sunday for you all to see as I know not everyone uses email. So keep an eye out for that video. We will probably play it a few times as the ministry develops. CityServe is the organization of local churches designed to identify key areas of crisis on our community and partner together to address those needs with a Christ-centered approach. For Klamath Falls, three areas of ministry focus have been identified. They are:

- -The Homeless Crisis
- -At-risk Youth/families
- -and Community Revitalization.


Together our church, along with many others in the basin will be developing practical ministries to bring the hope of the Gospel to these areas of hurt in word and action.

#### How Can I Participate?

I'm so glad you asked! There are several ways you can participate. First, join me and our church's tactical prayer teams in lifting these ministries in Prayer. Second, plan to attend CityFest on Saturday, May 27th and pray about inviting a non-believing friend or two. Free tickets will be available as we get into May and you can use these to invite folks. Third, prepare your heart and mind to join in on the upcoming community ministry projects that come out of our CityServe focus. While we have identified the three critical areas our ministries will address, we will be developing those in practical terms in the coming weeks.

I am very excited about this once-in-a-lifetime event coming to Klamath Falls. For many of us, this is an answer to prayer as we have been frustrated in attempts to develop meaningful partnerships with churches in town to address our communities need for salvation and other practical issues. The excitement and momentum of CityFest has already joined together many of our churches and helped ministers and congregations to connect. I look forward to what more God has in store for us. We have been praying for revival, it looks like God is answering!

## Sunday Bible Class, Spring 2023


### The Inter-Testamental Period
